CONCESSIONAL LICENSING RULES

CONCESSION CODE 404 VEHICLES

1. The Holden Car Club of WA Inc is a member of the C.M.C. (Council of Motoring Clubs of WA) and this body represents the interests of around 108 member car clubs in WA to the State Government, in particular, with respect to vehicle concessional licensing.
2. We, the Holden Car Club of WA Inc, must abide by the rules and regulations laid down to the C.M.C. by the Western Australian Government Licensing Authority.
3. Recent changes (2013) to the operation of Code 404 now see the owner being solely responsible for all aspects of the code and the operation of a roadworthy vehicle.

Code 404 requirements (Statutory Requirements)

1. Eligible vehicles are those 25 years or older.
2. Consistent with the Statutory Declaration noted in clause 4 of the **Holden Car Club of WA Inc Code 404 Requirements**, Vehicles must be factory standard or factory optioned. Modifications are not permitted, unless approved in writing by the C.M.C. Technical Committee. The onus is on the owner to fully comply with all the requirements of Code 404 including remaining a financial member of a Car Club at all times and maintaining the car in an original unmodified condition. Failure to do so will result in the vehicle being deemed unlicensed and therefore uninsured.
3. Vehicles are to be driven on club designated events or "Test Drive" only. Vehicles may also be used on any C.M.C. member club event for which the vehicle is eligible, including Impromptu Runs.
4. A "Test Drive" consists of a short drive to test vehicle after maintenance or for attending and returning from a repair or refuel facility.
5. Vehicles are not to be used for hire or reward or any non-club event.
6. Concessional identification plates or stickers with the word "HISTORIC" are purchased from the Holden Club of WA Inc for a nominated fee and remain the property of the vehicle owner.
"HISTORIC" plates or stickers must be displayed above or below WA License plates.
"HISTORIC" stickers are only to be used where it is impracticable to fit a metal plate, and must be adhered to a surface as vertical as practical, and as close to number plate as possible.

7. The concessional Licence is NOT TRANSFERABLE to any member of the public who is not a financial member of an approved car club. Therefore, should the vehicle be sold, the owner and the purchaser need to liaise with the DoT to make any necessary arrangements.
8. Should the vehicle be sold to a financial member of an approved car club, the purchaser should attend DoT Licensing with the proof of ownership and a financial member statement from their club as well as the DoT Vehicle Transfer form (MR9).

Holden Car Club of WA Inc Code 404 Requirements.

1. Owners that wish to have their vehicles on code 404 through the Club must be current financial members by the 30th June each year. No extension will be permitted; members **MUST** remain financial at all times.
2. The annual cost to have a vehicle entered onto the Holden Club register will be \$25, effective 2018, per car per annum (subject to annual review).
 - a. The Holden Car Club of WA Inc will require the car to be presented for inspection at a General Meeting, by prior arrangement, prior to acceptance for concessional license by the Holden Car Club of WA Inc.
 - b. For a vehicle to be considered for concessional license initially it must be currently registered, roadworthy and original.
 - c. The Holden Car Club of WA Inc reserves the right to reject an application for concessional license if in contravention of the above.
3. Vehicles may be used for weddings and funerals of close family members and friends. Approval must be sought from the Club and the authority carried in the vehicle.
4. When applying for a concessional license, owners must provide a statement of current financial membership, obtained from the Club Registrar as well as a DoT form E81 (Statutory Declaration) duly witnessed by the counter attendant at the licensing authority. The owner must provide a copy of the DoT E81 (Statutory Declaration) plus a copy of the new current Registration form to the Club Registrar.
5. Code 404 Proof of Membership and procedure letters are to be raised by the Registrar.
6. Members are encouraged to support the Club by way of attendance at Club organised events.
