9 CMC Report

- 9.1 The below points are from the minutes of the October Meeting that we have finally received, but as yet we have not received minutes for December's meeting.
- 9.2 A motion was passed stating "The CMC propose that changes to Code 404 as published on 7th September 2020 are rejected in total by the CMC approved clubs and the existing Code 404 rules be allowed to continue in operation."
- 9.3 Ferrari has been approved as a "Unique" vehicle.
- 9.4 Classic Car Show 2021 is being planned to go ahead, and they are looking for a volunteer to step up and become the coordinator for the event.
- 9.5 Currently 109 approved member clubs with the CMC.
- 9.6 A motion was raised by DLOC (Daimler & Lanchester Owners Club) to reduce 2021/2022 fees to \$20.00 per annum given the level of funds that the CMC has. A vote was taken with 10 in agreeance and 17 against, therefore the motion was lost, and the fees will remain at \$75.00.
- 9.7 Public liability was seen as a major cost rather than the CMC fee. It was noted that there is no legal requirement to use AJ Gallagher, and it was decided that the CMC will investigate Public Liability Insurance and pass on the outcome to the clubs as soon as further details are known.
