- Travel through Gnowerangerup to Stirling Range Retreat. Stay overnight. A variety of accommodation is available at Stirling Range Retreat and also Mt Trio Caravan Park. A BBQ tea will be provided along with entertainment. Media coverage, video, photos.
- Friday morning travel to Porongurups for morning tea and wine tasting. Social media promotion, photos.
- Display at Mt Barker for lunch. Social media promotion, photos.
- Travel to Albany for publicity and photos at National ANZAC Centre.
- Depart to accommodation.




